Title 1 History

- Title One is one of the components of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965.
- Created to address inequality in education.
- It's most current version is the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) passed in 2015.



Title 1 Funds = Federal Funds

- Title 1 funding is based on the % of students who receive free/reduced lunch.
 - Fill out lunch form or visit the DOE School Food Services Branch Website to sign up.
 - Regular Breakfast - \$1.10 **Reduced Breakfast - \$0.30**
 - Regular Lunch - \$2.50 **Reduced Lunch - \$0.40**
- SY 18-19, Kaahumanu's % of Free/Reduced Students = **70.9%** (school calculation)
- School-wide Program - Monies are used to help all students



SY 18-19 QKS Title 1 Program

- SY 18-19 QKS Title 1 Funding = **\$196,370**
- For SY 18-19, Title 1 monies will be used for:
 - 1 Class-size Reduction Teacher
 - Part Time Teachers & Tutors in Reading & Math
 - Training/Planning Days for Teachers
 - Parent Involvement Activities: Winter Literacy Night, STEM Nights
 - Universal Screeners - iReady & DIBELS
 - Computer Program - Brain Pop
 - Accessible from home
