Purpose of the Study

Positive school climate is an essential component of successful and effective schools. It is defined as shared beliefs, values, and attitudes that shape interactions between students, teachers, and administrators, while setting the parameters of acceptable behavior and norms for a school.

The Pleasanton Unified School District (PUSD) asked students in grades 6–12, parents, and staff members for feedback on the most important dimensions of school climate. Results will inform decisions at both the school and district levels. This was the first administration of the survey.

K12 Insight partnered with district leaders to develop the survey, which addressed the following topics:

- Overall school quality
- Academic support
- Student support
- School leadership
- Family involvement
- Safety and behavior
- Communication and community building



Details of the Study

The survey was open April 30 to May 23.

Email invitations with unique survey links were sent to parents and staff members. Parents could also access the survey via a public link on the district's website. Paper surveys were available on request. The parent survey was translated into Chinese and Spanish.

Students used their student IDs to access the survey in school.

Pre-survey communications included email, letters to parents, and social media posts. Reminders were sent on April 18, 20, 24, and 30, and May 3 and 8.

This report summarizes survey results, which are broken down by group: parents, students, and staff.


Results do not reflect random sampling; therefore, they should not be generalized to the all PUSD students in grades 6–12, parents, and staff members.



Communication and Community Building items appear as 'Pleasanton USD Custom' in the highest and lowest ranking indicator tables.




Dimension Scores: Comparison by Respondent Type






Academic Support: Comparison by Respondent Type








Family Involvement: Comparison by Respondent Type






