QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

*** What is ASB?**

Associated Student Body is a group of students that plan and run student-based activities.

*** What does the ASB card get me?**

Discounts on event tickets, yearbook purchase, spirit wear and much more.

*** When do I get my schedule?**

On the first day of school, students will report to a room, which is assigned by their last name. Schedules will be given out and students will report to their 1st period class.

*** What time can students be dropped off?**

Supervision begins at 8:00 a.m. Students are allowed through the gates at 8:15 a.m.

*** Are there buses?**

*** How are students assigned to teams?**

Team assignments are made randomly by the computer.

*** Can students buy breakfast at school?**

Some breakfast items are sold before school, but it is best to grab breakfast at home.

*** Can parents open a cafeteria account for their student?**

Money can be put on account using your student's ID card by:

- Writing a check made out to WSHUHSD

- It takes about three days for the funds to be available on accounts
