Last year's tests, newly created standards-aligned tests, Performance Tasks, Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs), Interim Comprehensive Assessments (ICAs), or assessments that accompany curriculum are all good choices.

Plan ahead with your grade level to ensure each assessment is administered, scored and the results are inputted within the window so that meaningful analysis can take place.
