



Catalina Outdoor Science Camp 7th Grade Overnight UPDATE

Dates: Wednesday, March 6 – Friday, March 8

Cost per person: \$350

Cost for this 3 day/2-night trip includes: Bus transportation from the school to the ferry, ferry ride to Catalina, accommodations in cabins, 6 meals, all planned activities on the island (including wet suit use for snorkeling), and ferry & bus transportation back to the school.

Payment Plan (per person)

First half due on November 7th

Final balance due on December 3rd

If you are interested in being a chaperone for this trip, please read the following entirely:

Chaperones are needed on this trip, however, they must meet certain criteria. We need parents who can assist in supervising students, including camp activities, meal time, sleeping, and free time. The camp requires a swim safety test to participate in these activities, which includes a short swim and getting out of and back into a kayak while in open water. Parents will participate with the students in snorkeling and kayaking. A life vest will be worn during all water activities. If you are willing to perform the above described actions as a chaperone, and are willing to pay the above cost for yourself as well, please return payment for yourself along with your student's payment. We'd love to have you be a part of this trip!

Additional Requirements:

To participate in a field trip, the following is required:

For this overnight trip, you do not need to be an approved field trip driver. You **DO** need to be an approved TVCS volunteer which requires completion of the Volunteer Handbook & Application found under the PARENTS tab on our website (www.tvcscougars.com) and all the requirements listed in this handbook. Live Scan fingerprinting and criminal background check results (FBI & DOJ) must be received by TVCS Administration no less than one month prior to the field trip. We recommend having the Live Scan done ASAP as we will not be able to give a refund if the results are not received by the school 30 days prior to the trip. The Live Scan form is also found on the school website under the PARENTS tab.
