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Brea Olinda USD Seeks Community Input on Educational Priorities for Annual LCAP

BREA, Calif. - The Brea Olinda Unified School District (BOUSD) is seeking community input on the educational priorities to be included in its annual Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), which ensures that funding is budgeted to target the needs of all students at BOUSD. Today, the District launched an LCAP Online Survey that is available in English and Spanish and is open April 4, 2016, through May 6, 2016.

The state LCAP requires all school districts to seek parent, community, district staff and student input to set goals in priority areas that serve high-quality educational programs for all students, including identified subgroups of English Learners, Low Income and Foster Youth.

The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) has been passed by state legislation to allow local insight and meaningful conversations to take place between parents, employees and the community about their schools. Stakeholders' recommendations will be compiled in a report that will be provided to the Board of Education. After a public hearing, the governing Board of Education must review and approve the BOUSD Local Control Accountability Plan for the 2016-17 school year in June, 2016.
