



St. Landry Parish Summer School 2018 Grades 7 - 12

Virtual/Online Courses will be used for 2018 Summer School for grades 7-12. Virtual courses are taught by certified teachers. The district will provide one facilitator per lab or setting. The number of facilitators needed (~1 per 25-50 students) will be determined at a later date, according to the number of students enrolled in virtual courses. The district currently has several teachers trained as facilitators.

Registration will be Thursday, May 24, 2018 for all students (grades 7-12) at Opelousas High School from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Students may take only one course.

Opelousas High School (Grades 7-12)
Full credit course: 20 days (May 29 – June 25)
Half credit course : 10 days (May 29 – June 11)
7:30 am – 12:00 pm

****Students must agree to attend the full duration of the course and pay the enrollment fee in order for their registration to be completed. Successful completion of all site-based lessons is required during summer school for full credit and ½ credit courses.**

Registration/Orientation is required for all students prior to the official start date.



St. Landry Parish Summer School 2018 Grades 7 - 12 Guidelines

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible students must have been actively enrolled as a 2017-2018 student in a public or non-public school, have received a final grade of F in a course, and have all required forms completed, including required signatures – principal, student, and parent.

Courses may not be taken for original credit.

REGISTRATION

Registration is scheduled Thursday, **May 24, 2018** for all students (7-12) at Opelousas High School from 8:00am – 10:30 am. Fees are \$350.00 **per class** (\$175.00 for ½ credit course). Students may register for **one course only**. Full payment is due at the time of registration. Registration will not be accepted without payment. We will accept cash, money order or a certified check. Money orders and certified checks should be made payable to: **St. Landry Parish School Board**. Please include the student's name and student ID on the check. **We will not accept personal checks.**

STUDENT CONDUCT

Students are expected to follow all summer school rules as described.

GRADE REPORTS

Final grades for **all** classes will be sent to the schools.

REFUNDS

No Refunds will be considered.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents are responsible for providing transportation. All students must be dropped off and picked up at the student drop-off area located at the side (covered canopy) of Opelousas High School.

RULES OF CONDUCT

The rules of conduct for Summer School are similar to the policy rules students must follow during the regular school year; however, there will be no suspensions for misconduct or other policy violations. Students who violate the rules, or who have more than the allowed number of absences or tardies will be subject to immediate withdrawal.

ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend all sessions and arrive on time.

Only one absence is allowed.

STUDENT DRIVERS

Students are to be courteous and respectful to staff members and other students at all times. Parking will be on the side of OHS. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in withdrawal from Summer School.

STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students are expected to dress in **school uniforms**.

Any apparel that causes or is likely to cause a disruption to the instructional program is prohibited.

Hats or other head coverings are not to be worn in the building.

St. Landry Parish Summer School reserves the right to refuse admittance to any student not dressed appropriately, and if sent home, the student will earn an absence.

Break

Students will have a 30 minute lunch break at approximately 10:30 a.m.

Students may not use the snack and soda machines during class time.
