BLOCK 2: NUMBER BY PREFERENCE (1-5)

Also, students explore activities to build cognitive skills through circuitry, problem solving tasks, and imaginative building.

Art Class

Summer Fun means art fun. Students will engage in fun-filled creative art activities equal to a magic carpet ride.

Science Thrills

Children will be amazed when they participate in experiments, which may include creating a visible tornado, experiment with changing the color of flowers, make slime, ice cream, and rock candy, volcanoes, and explore with matter changing physically and chemically! And much more!
