

## GRANT AGREEMENT

This GRANT AGREEMENT is made and entered into effective July 1, 2014, by and between the Appalachian Life Quality Initiative (ALQI) and Oneida Special School District (The Grantee).

ALQI has approved a grant of **\$17,518.00** for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2014.

ALQI makes this grant subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. All of the grant funds are to be used for improving the healthcare of the underserved children in the Oneida Special School District and Scott County, Tennessee.
2. The Grantee agrees that the funds will be used for programs listed with the budget submitted by the Grantee as part of this grant agreement.
3. The Grantee agrees to keep financial and other records so that they can adequately show the use of grant funds exclusively for the grant purposes.
4. This Agreement constitutes the full understanding of the parties and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee. This Grant Agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by authorized officers of ALQI and the Oneida Special School District.
5. Grantee agrees to bill ALQI on a monthly basis, beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015 (12 invoices).


Oneida Special School District agrees to this grant subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. ALQI agrees that any personnel hired under this grant shall be employees of the Oneida Special School District and will be required to abide by all laws and policies of the Oneida Special School District Board of Education.
2. ALQI agrees that personnel hired under this grant will collaborate with other professionals in planning to assure the quality of health education provided to students and network with other community agencies to assess, plan, implement, and evaluate school health services in the broad continuum of promotion of primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention.
3. ALQI agrees to provide funds on a reimbursement basis from the monthly invoices submitted by OSSD, beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015 (12 invoices total).
4. ALQI and the Oneida Special School District shall at all times comply with the regulations of Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex, age, color, creed, national origin or mental handicap.
