Student Assessments

Students in K-3rd grade will participate in the *Middle of Year* Istation assessment beginning on January 9. This assessment is used by teachers to guide reading instruction for students. Results from Istation will show us how much growth students have made in reading since the beginning of the school year. The assessment is familiar to students and should only take up to an hour to complete. If you have a child in K-3rd grade, please make sure they are well rested on the day they participate in the assessment and that they eat a nutritious breakfast. The assessment schedule will be sent home with students on Tuesday.

As many of you may have heard, New Mexico's new Governor, Michelle Lujan Grisham signed an executive order that will ultimately end students taking the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) test in our state. At this time, we are not sure what this means for the 2018/2019 school year as students will have to have some sort of measure to show school and individual progress. We will keep you updated as we learn information.
