

2019- KALAHEO HIGH SCHOOL PTSA SCHOLARSHIP

The Kalaheo's Parent Teacher Student Association has put together a total scholarship of \$2,000 towards post-High School education. This year of 2019, there will be enough for three students. Specifically, one (1) recipient will be awarded \$1,000, and two (2) will receive \$500.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

We are looking for students who will continue to make a positive change in the world. If you have made a difference in your school by participating in clubs, NJROTC, athletics, and/or other school events, we would like to meet you!

1. Student and/ or Parent must be/become a member of the 2019-2020 SY Kalaheo PTSA. For new membership, the PTSA membership application (form attached) and fee (\$30 personal check) must be submitted with the scholarship application.
2. Student must be scheduled to graduate from Kalaheo High School in 2019.
3. Student must have applied to an accredited university/college, junior college, or trade/training school.

PROCESS

Students must hand deliver their complete signed packet to Ms. April Inouye, Kalaheo High School College & Career Counselor by **Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. in Room H-208**. She will then assign students their fifteen (15) minute interview slots.

Each application will be reviewed by a PTSA panel of independent judges (e.g., Scholarship Committee, PTSA President). Deciding factors may include how many applicants apply, what their accomplishments were, and how prompt the applicants were in each part of the process. Every applicant will be interviewed.

The 15-minute (max) interviews are to be held on **Wednesday, April 10, 2019 (starting at 1:30 until finished in Room H-208)**. These interviews will give each applicant an opportunity to show who they are to the panel. It also gives the panel a chance to ask any additional questions. Students will be judged on their punctuality, appearance, demeanor/attitude, and ability to express themselves. The best three (3) students (per application and interview) will be selected for the above-mentioned scholarship amounts.

You will need the following paperwork:

1. Completed Application
2. Personal Statement (e.g., *Why should you be one of the scholarship recipients?*)
3. Copy of School Transcript (unofficial copy is acceptable)
4. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation from people who believe that you have the potential to do well in college/university, etc. They must have known you for more than six (6) months and not be related to you. Examples are: your faculty, NJROTC Instructor, coach, boss, pastor,
