Dear Cypress School District Families:

Thank you for your ongoing patience and support as we work to effectively address health and safety concerns associated with the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

Last night, the Governor issued [Executive Order N-33-20](#) directing Californians to stay at home until further notice. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, **student dismissal in the Cypress School District will continue until such time that it is deemed safe for our students to return to school.** The district is working closely with state and local authorities, as well as our county partners, throughout this emergency. We will continue to monitor conditions associated with COVID-19 and update our families regarding any changes to the student dismissal period in the Cypress School District.

Our teachers have been working hard this week to provide a variety of lessons and educational activities for students. Over spring break, the district will develop a comprehensive plan for distance learning that will support student education during the dismissal period and through the end of the school year if it becomes necessary. More information on our distance learning plan will be provided for families following spring break.

Student meal service will continue. Please see the enclosure for further details about accessing school meals during the dismissal period.

As always, we will continue to provide our school community with timely district updates as new information becomes available. In the meantime, we urge families to abide by the Governor's Executive Order and to do their part in observing social distancing and following other important guidelines provided by the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) and the [Orange County Health Care Agency](#). Working together, we can help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and support the health and safety of everyone in our local community.
