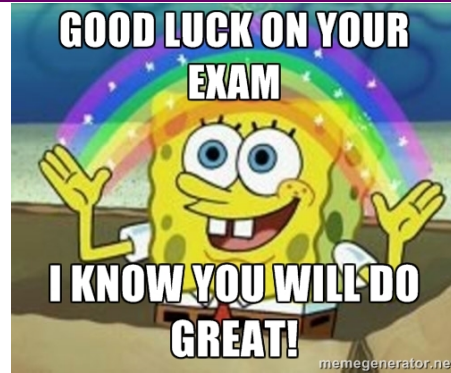

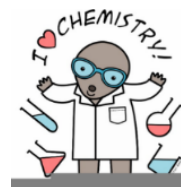
### TUBE TOPS

## NEW ENGINEERING CLASS OFFERED in 19/20

If you are interested in exploring the world of engineering and STEM based careers, **Career & College Readiness will be offering Principles of Engineering (POE) after school in the 19/20 school year.** This class is for students who like to learn by doing and who are interested in activity-based problem solving. There is no experience necessary for POE, but solid math skills will aid in student's success and enjoyment of the class. POE explores engineering design problems through robotics, automation, and programming. This class fulfills the A-G Elective Credit requirement and is part of the nationally recognized Project Lead the Way engineering pathway. **The class will be offered T/Th 4-7pm at Saugus H.S.** If you are looking for a hands-on elective in the world of science and technology outside of the normal school day, please see **Mrs. Olinger in the counseling department before the class fills up.**



## ATTENTION SOPHOMORES & JUNIORS

Valencia High School and College of the Canyons (COC) will be offering **COUNS 110 CAREER/LIFE PLANNING as a Dual Enrollment class next year.** The Dual Enrollment (DE) program gives high school students the opportunity to take college courses on their own high school campus **during the school for free.** Dual Enrollment awards dual credit, high school elective credit and college credit. **COUNS 110 CAREER/LIFE PLANNING will meet every day EXCEPT Wednesdays, during 7<sup>th</sup> period here on campus.** This class introduces self-assessment tools to identify college majors and careers by clarifying interests, skills, values, and personality type. Students also examine the decision-making process, self-management, life roles and goal-setting. Includes a review of labor market trends, career research, interviewing skills, resume and cover letter writing and job search strategies.
