PART IB :

- Basic Information: Artist, Title, Year made, Original Location (if known)
- Basic description of each actual piece
- What you think about the work, do you like, dislike, or are indifferent about it? (**AND WHY!**)
- Why do you think it’s in the museum and why are people coming to see it?
