

What is REACH?

REACH (Reaching Excellence At College Heights) is a college preparatory program for students with a 2.5-3.5 GPA and a strong desire to attend a 4-year college or university. **REACH** targets students in the middle with academic potential capable of completing a college degree. **REACH** is an approach to encouraging students in the academic middle to achieve greater heights with rigorous courses while offering the support to be successful in those courses. **REACH** encourages acceleration over remediation. **REACH** provides tutorial assistance, academic counseling, assistance for students in meeting UC/CSU admissions requirements, assistance in college search and selection, career exploration and awareness including guest speakers, and CAASPP/SAT/ACT Preparation. Students learn effective study skills, collaboration, inquiry, Cornell Notes, writing and share the goal of attending a four-year college. The program compels teachers, administrators, tutors and students to work together to achieve success in and out of the classroom, especially to encourage a college-going culture.
