



## Academic Scholarship Criteria and Application

St. Edmund Preparatory High School (SEP) annually awards a number of academic scholarships to qualified incoming freshmen. These scholarships range from partial to full awards to those candidates who meet the criteria. This application must be completed in full and returned to the Office of Admissions no later than **Wednesday, October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018**. Late submissions cannot be accepted.

### Qualification Criteria

1. Applicants must be eighth-grade students applying for admission to the SEP Class of 2023.
2. Applicants who mark St. Edmund Preparatory High School as their **first** or **second** choice on the TACHS Examination are given preference to those who mark SEP **third**.
3. Applicants' **overall average** must be 90% or greater for the entirety of the seventh and first half of the eighth grade.
4. Applicants' **overall grades** in each of the core academic subjects (including, at the minimum, Mathematics, Science, Language Arts and Social Studies) must be 90% or greater for the entirety of the seventh and first half of the eighth grade.
5. Applicants must take the required SEP Scholarship Examination (administered on Saturday, November 10, 2018 at 8:30 AM).
6. Due to possible conflicts with other scholarship exams for different schools, the make-up date for the exam will be **Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>**. **This will be the only make-up date.**

From among those applicants who meet each of the above requirements, select candidates will be invited to interview with the Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Committee is responsible for awarding all SEP academic scholarships.

- **Note:** an original, official copy of the applicant's most recent transcript (grades six, seven, and eight) must be received by **December 13, 2018**. Transcripts must come directly from the applicant's current school. **Public School parents must request** that their Guidance Office send their child's transcript to St. Edmund Prep. Catholic Elementary Schools will send transcripts automatically if we are one of your child's choices. We only need one copy for TACHS and Scholarship Exam.
