### Cheney High School Is One Of America's Top High Schools

Newsweek released its coveted list of America's Top High Schools 2016 - and CHS was ranked among 500 schools across our country that are doing a stellar job of preparing students for college despite their challenging economic status.

U.S. News has once again ranked Cheney High School as one of the best high schools in Washington State for 2016. They reviewed over 28,000 U.S. public high schools. A four-step process determined the Best High Schools. The first three steps ensured that the schools serve all of their students well, using their performance on the math and reading parts of their state proficiency tests and graduation rates. A fourth step assessed the degree to which schools prepare students for college-level work, using Advanced Placement test data as the benchmark for success. The top-scoring schools received a gold, silver or bronze medal. CHS received a Bronze Award.

The Gold Star Award was given by Governor Jay Inslee in 2014 for the district's top-performance in the state in terms of sign-ups for the College Bound Scholarship. College Bound, now in its ninth year, continues to encourage students to dream big and pursue a college education. The early commitment of state dollars provides an opportunity and pathway for Washington students who might not have otherwise considered a postsecondary education.
