## Parents' Rights and Responsibilities

As a parent you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's teacher and of any paraprofessional who provides instructional services to your child.

**ALL** teachers and staff are highly qualified in our elementary schools.

You have the right to have a voice in how parent involvement funds are spent in the school.

Please attend the School Improvement Team meetings held once a month. Check with your school to get the actual day and time. You may also share your ideas at a PTO meeting or a PAC meeting.

You have the right to receive the county Parent Involvement Policy as well as the school level policy.

You have the right to receive the county Parent Involvement Policy as well as the county complaint policy. A copy of the county policy was distributed at the annual meeting.

You have a responsibility to help revise the school's Parent Involvement Policy annually.

You have the right to know what Title I means to you and your child.

You have the responsibility to help revise the Home-School Compact.
