At first, there were only 3 student-directed one-act plays. During the 1980's, Miss Moselli added the senior play/ non-competitive play to the slate and expanded the awards to include: Best actor, best actress, best supporting actor, best supporting actress and best play/director

During the **2013-2014** school year, many technical changes took place. First, the sound system was overhauled and the sound board was moved to its position in the balcony. Next, the lights and electrical systems needed major repairs. The large electrical unit from stage left was replaced with a nice, thin panel on the wall. All of the stage “strip lights” were replaced with cool LED lights and the “floods” ellipsoidal lights from the bar on the

ceiling were replaced with LED ellipsoidal lights. The light board was also relocated to the balcony!! Finally, the lighting technician could actually see what he's doing! We also installed an intercom system with headsets so the people working at the balcony table can communicate with those who are backstage left.
