PAINTER

QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) High School Diploma or equivalent.
- (2) Four years experience at a skilled journeyman level.
- (3) Valid Florida driver's license.
- (4) May also require a valid Florida CDL Class B license.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledgeable and have the ability in applying paint and sealers to a variety of surfaces by use of brushes, rollers or spray gun (conventional and airless). Knowledgeable of hazards and safety precaution of this painting trade. Ability to receive supervision and assignments of work both orally and through written job orders from a maintenance supervisor or lead person.

Maintenance Foreman

JOB GOAL

To complete assigned work at the journeyman level in the painting and preparation of interior and exterior of all types of buildings.

SUPERVISES:

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- (1) Maintain knowledge and be able to prepare surfaces to be painted, remove dirt, scales, rust, old paint, grease and other materials.
- (2) Scrape, sand, pressure clean, sandblast and apply sizing.
- (3) Be very knowledgeable in how to apply paints, sealers, varnishes to interior and exterior of buildings, furniture and equipment.
- (4) Able to use spray guns, rollers, brushes, sandblasters and other equipment that may be used in this field.
- (5) Maintain knowledge in staining, using a brush or rag or dip objects into various stains; stain shelving, benches, tables and cabinets prior to sealing or varnishing.
- (6) Be knowledgeable in different types of paints, sealers and other materials.
- (7) Be able to estimate material for jobs.
- (8) Maintain knowledge and be able to repair plaster, cement, concrete block, drywall, re-lettering of signs and stenciling, clean brushes, rollers, spray guns and make minor repairs to equipment.
- (9) Be very knowledgeable and be able to rig and erect scaffolding, haul and erect ladders.
- (10) Do a variety of other work closely related to painting for a minor proportion of the time.
- (11) Apply waterproofing to building walls, floors, cut old caulking compounds and insert new.

- (12) Be able to complete cost cards, work orders and other paperwork that is required.
- (13) Have ability to do striping of parking lots and tracks.
- (14) May be required to wear respirator for some tasks.
- (15) Use effective, positive interpersonal communication skills.
- (16) Perform other incidental tasks consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
- (17) Other duties assigned by the immediate administrator or supervisor.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Medium Work: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 10 pounds of force as needed to move objects.
