

## **WCMS Honor Roll and Attendance Awards Guidelines 19-20**

### **PERFECT ATTENDANCE:**

- Recognized by Attendance Office
- No absences for any reason (excused or unexcused)
- No check-ins or check-outs
- “All day . . . Every day”!

### **CITIZENSHIP:**

- Recognized by Homeroom teacher- one student per quarter
- Student must have E's and S's

### **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT:**

- Recognized by classroom teachers
- Each teacher sets their own criteria

### **SEMESTER HONOR ROLL:**

- Qualify for honor roll both Quarters – We do not look at semester averages  
*For example: If you make an 80% C 1<sup>st</sup> QUARTER and a 90% B 2<sup>nd</sup> QUARTER – your semester average is 85% B but you must qualify each quarter so you would not get semester honor roll*
- Conduct Grades assigned by teachers must be E's and S's
- Faculty Honor Roll – A's and B's
- Principal's Honor Roll – All A's
- Student that has Faculty one quarter and Principal one quarter will be on SEMESTER FACULTY HONOR ROLL.
- Students with ISS/OSS receive a mandatory N in conduct through their grade level administrator and will not qualify for Honor Roll.

### **YEAR LONG HONOR ROLL:**

- Qualify for honor roll each semester – We do not look at yearly averages
- Faculty Honor Roll – Both Faculty Semester Honor Rolls or One Faculty/One Principal Honor Roll
- Principal's Honor Roll – Both Principal Semester Honor Rolls
- Student that has Faculty one semester and Principal one semester will be on Year-Long Faculty Honor Roll

Students are recognized for semester one at the January awards ceremonies.  
Students are recognized for semester two and year-long awards at the May awards ceremonies.
