Student Parking Lot

Reminder that students may only park their vehicle in the West Ranch student parking lot with a valid 2018-2019 Parking Permit. This parking permit MUST be displayed at all times. Failure to display the parking permit will result in a parking ticket. All cars must be parked in a valid parking spot, you may not park in front of a barricade or along a curb. Tickets are being issued daily. If you don't have a parking permit, you cannot park in the student parking lot.
