Dear Dover School District Families,

As mentioned earlier in today's correspondence, the Dover School District reconvened the COVID-19 Response Team. After further review of what is occurring in our community and surrounding communities, the decision has been made to close the Dover Schools starting Monday, March 16 through Friday, March 27. At the end of the two-week period, the Response Team will re-evaluate the status of the COVID-19 pandemic.

On Saturday, March 14, the Response Team will be meeting for further planning in order to provide remote learning and continuation of food service for families in need. Once the planning is completed, additional information will be provided on remote learning and other services.

On Monday, March 16 and Tuesday, March 17, teachers will be having professional planning to prepare for remote learning for students.

The purpose of this early communication is to allow families to start planning for the needs of your family for the next two weeks.

We appreciated your patience as we continued our reassessment of the changing conditions surrounding COVID-19. It will be important that we all work together to make the next two weeks purposeful learning for the Dover School District students.
