Dear Eyler Families,

I always talk about reading with your kids and I would like to share a tip about helping them learn and read new vocabulary words. A large vocabulary can turn your child into a better reader and writer. When you and your child visit places, point out words that people use. Maybe a waiter describes an entrée or the dentist talks about molars. Encourage your child to figure out what they mean by the way they are used.

Try to take them beyond common nouns. Have your child add verbs and adjectives to their vocabulary. Sports and games offer opportunities to use action words. Let your child hear you comment on the softball that *soars* or the runner who *sprints*. These simple steps can truly make a difference.

Finally, parents please be sure that you read with your children for 20 minutes and ask them every day what new things they have learned at school.
