Applications are completed and submitted online. Nothing is submitted to St. Anthony School.

Along with the application, each family must pay a \$29 non-refundable fee to FACTS to apply for Fulcrum tuition assistance. If you have more than one child attending a catholic school, only one application and one fee is required.

The deadline for submitting your application online is January 4, 2019. No Fulcrum applications will be accepted or considered for funding after the deadline. The application is available in both English and Spanish.

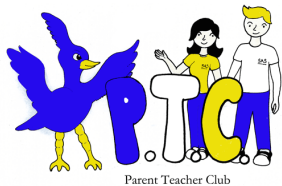
New Volunteer Opportunities

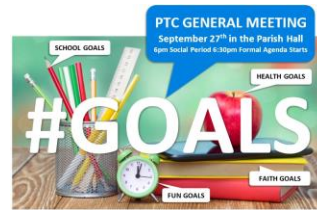
