## CHS Set To Take Final Exams on January 9 & 10, 2020

As the first semester comes to a close, CHS students are preparing to take final exams next Thursday and Friday. Final exams at CHS can consist both of a comprehensive exam or unit exam.

All CHS students who do not have a Final Exam during a given period have the option of "open campus" or can report to the library for additional studying. Students in need of lunch during Final Exams will need to report it to the Main Office by Monday, January 6th.

A comprehensive exam will cover the entire curriculum of the semester and a unit exam will cover specific essential learning targets within the last unit covered. Students are encouraged to take the time to prepare for their exams so that they earn the highest grade possible. Some helpful tips for students include: create your own study guide, ask questions, attend or host review sessions, start studying early, stay well rested, set a study schedule, quiz yourself, meet with your teacher, reorganize your notes, visualize your success and have fun!

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## 2020 WINTER CHEERLEADING CLINIC

The Carlisle High School Cheerleaders will be conducting a cheerleading clinic on Thursday, February 13, 2020 and Friday, February 14, 2020 from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. **PLEASE NOTE – WE WILL ONLY MEET TWO DAYS! (all ages will meet both days)** Students in Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grades are eligible. Thursday and Friday practices will be held in the south elementary gym (by playground). (Kindergarten students will be escorted to the gym both days) T-shirts and shorts/sweat pants, socks and tennis shoes should be worn to practice. **Please remove all jewelry. The Iowa Athletic Association states that all jewelry must be removed while cheering and practicing. Please note, this rule is enforced for safety.**

CHS Cheerleaders will teach the students a short dance, chants and a cheer. The students will perform during halftime (6:20 p.m.) of the girls varsity basketball game (game time 6:00 p.m.). Please arrive at the WAC (Wildcat Activity Center – new gym) no later than 6:00 p.m. Students will be escorted to the student section in the gym. Parents will meet their children after the performance in the back area of the lobby, by the concession stand.

The cost of the clinic is \$25 which includes a t-shirt and snacks after practice. T-shirts are to be worn to the game (this is your ticket to get in free) however, **families will need to pay admission.** Please make **checks payable to CHS Cheerleading.** Parental permission and injury waiver slip must be returned in a sealed envelope to the school offices by **Friday, January 31, 2020.**

Please pick up your child promptly at 5:00 p.m. in the gym. No child will be allowed to leave the gym without an adult (older sister/brother) **signing them out.** If practice location is changed there will be signs hanging on the front entrance of the Elementary building (where buses pick up/drop off).
