In his press conference today, Governor Abbott asked the citizens of Texas to continue the practice of social distancing for 15 days, in the hope of limiting the spread of the COVID19 virus. The Navarro ISD will comply by extending school closure through April 10. At this time we are hopeful that students will be able to return to campus on Monday, April 13.

In the meantime, Navarro teachers have prepared remote lessons for instructional continuity. It is vital for students to engage daily in the learning process that is being provided. Someone will be at each campus to answer phones from 9 AM to 2 PM Monday through Thursday if you need assistance, and the technology department is standing by to provide tech support.
