

## **Materials Needed in 7<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Students will need supplies **both** here **at school** and available **at home** for their core classes (language arts, math, science and social studies).

- ***The students should have available at home:*** colored pencils, markers, glue, stapler, ruler, protractor, lined paper, pencils, and a scientific calculator.
- ***The students should have available here at school:*** LOTS of PENCILS, pencil top erasers, colored pencils / markers, dry erase markers( each student will need a set for Science) highlighters, **earbuds** and 6 pack of glue sticks. They will use them in all their CORE classes.

### **In addition to the above, students will also need:**

- **P.O.W.E.R. Time** – Providing Opportunities for Everyday Reading – silent reading time for all TKMS students & staff from 9:35-9:50. Students must have a **book or magazine everyday.**

- **Language Arts:** 1 folder or binder. 1 single subject notebook. Writing utensils every day. Highlighters, glue sticks, and scissors are recommended. Last names A-J: 1 container of Lysol Wipes. Last names K-T: 1 package Post it Notes. Last names U-Z: 1 BIG glue stick.
- **Social Studies:** one folder (just for social studies), pencils to last the school year. Donations of Kleenex and/or Lysol wipes appreciated.
- **Science:** A composition notebook(without the spiral binding), folder or 3 ring binder or a section in a large binder to hold their science materials until they are stapled into their notebook (journal), a set of dry erase markers, colored pencils, calculator, lots and lots of pencils and pencil top erasers.
- **Math Class:** Pencils & erasers, 3-ring binder, earbuds, protractor, and lots of whiteboard markers. Clorox Wipes or Kleenex are needed & appreciated!
- **Reading Labs:** 1 subject spiral notebook to leave in class
- **Reading Extension:** 1 2-pocket folder, one inch three ring binder (just for RE) and sticky notes.
- **Social Studies Extension** 1 2-pocket folder, colored pencils or markers, Clorox wipes or Kleenex.
