Now What??

➤ **Decide where you want to attend college**

➤ **Take the SAT, ACT, or ACCUPLACER college entrance exams required for your college**

Different programs could require different tests. You must take a college entrance exam and have your scores sent to the college. Please be aware of all registration deadlines.

1. Apply to ABAC or SRTC

Please meet with your counselor if you need assistance.

Provide supporting materials (transcript, immunization, etc.) to college Admissions Office. There may be an application fee.

2. Schedule an advisement conference for you, your parent/guardian, and your school counselor by deadline.

Call (229) 387-2475 Ext. 8513 (Counseling Office) to schedule a mandatory advisement meeting with your school counselor. You and your parent/guardian must attend this mandatory advisement session, where you will complete required paperwork, discuss college course options, high school graduation requirements, and update your individualized graduation plan. Student will receive a Dual Enrollment Schedule Request Form (pink copy).

3. Schedule an appointment with your college's Dual Enrollment High School Coordinator:

4. Bring a copy of your college schedule to your TCHS school counselor.

UPDATED

Deadlines and Test Dates have been extended for Dual Enrollment for the upcoming school year. If you are interested in taking classes at SRTC or ABAC you must apply to the college and be accepted. In order to apply for ABAC you must have taken the SAT or ACT. In order to apply for SRTC, you must have taken the ACCUPLACER, SAT, or ACT.

Additional Test Dates left to register for Dual Enrollment next year- Summer 2019 and Fall 2019:

- ACT – April 13 – Register by March 8. Register at www.actstudent.org
- ACT-Residual- Test Dates - March 20 and April 18– Offered at ABAC; Contact Ms. Jackson (rjackson@abac.edu or testing@abac.edu) or call the testing center at 391-4817. There is a fee for the ACT-Residual.
- ACCUPLACER – Test Dates – Now through April 18 - Offered at SRTC; Contact Mrs. Ponder (mponder@southernregional.edu) or call 391-2600 and ask for admissions. Be sure to tell admissions staff that you are a TCHS student.

Students may take the ACT, SAT, and ACCUPLACER at later dates if planning on taking Dual Enrollment courses Spring 2020 (January).

Summer 2019:

Meet with your school counselor- **ASAP**

Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **March 29, 2019**

Fall 2019:

See dates above

Meet with your school counselor- **Feb. 28 – April 22, 2019**

Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **April 30, 2019**

Spring 2020:

SAT- last acceptable test option-**Aug. 24, 2019** (anticipated date)

ACT- last acceptable test option- **Sept. 14, 2019** (anticipated date)

Meet with your school counselor- **Feb. 28 – April 22, 2019**

Meet with your school counselor again- Sept. 26-Oct. 31, 2019

Return your college schedule to your high school counselor by- **Dec. 4, 2019**
