2019 GREATER SPOKANE LEAGUE CHAMPIONS MEAD PANTHER GIRLS GOLF

Girls Golf – The Girls tied Lewis & Clark for 1st at last week’s final GSL match, played at Deer Park GC. With that finish, they earned the **2019 Greater Spokane League Team Title**. Boys Golf – The Boys were 5th at Deer Park, but finished 3rd in the League standings and also qualified for **today’s District 8 Golf Tournament** to be held at MeadowWood Golf Course. Thursday, the Boys are playing in a new golf event for Spokane area golfers – **The High School Golf Championships** – being played at the Kalispel Golf & Country Club.

Boys & Girls Track – The Boys were 2nd and the Girls 3rd at this weekend’s **GSL Championships** held at Central Valley High School. For the Boys, it was another close one, losing to Central Valley by just 3 points! The Boys qualified 21 to this week’s **District 8 Meet** and the Girls will be taking 19 to Richland.

Boys Tennis – Mead qualified both Doubles Teams for this weekend’s **District 8 Tennis Tournament** in Pasco.

Girls Tennis – The Girls qualified their Doubles Team of **Sophie Koehler & Luca Mistereck** as well as Singles players **Allie Flynn & Cambry Robbins** for this weekend’s **District 8 Tennis Tournament** in Hanford.

Softball – District 8 Softball Tournament - The Girls traveled to the undefeated and #1 seeded Richland Bombers on Tuesday and lost 10-0. Friday, they played at University for a chance to advance in the tournament and keep their season alive. After tying the game at three in the 4th inning, the University scored 7 times in their half of the 4th inning to take a 10-3 lead. Mead made it interesting down the stretch and had the tying run at the plate in the 7th inning, but came up just short, losing 10-7. **Peyton Cushner** homered for Mead.

Baseball – District 8 Baseball Tournament - The Boys also traveled to Richland on Tuesday to face the #1 seeded Bombers and dropped a 9-4 decision. **Braeden Cordes** had 2 hits for the Panthers. Mead was the host site this Saturday for the District 8 Loser’s Bracket Semifinals and Final. The Panthers lost 2-1 to Central Valley in 8 innings, coming up just short of playing for a chance to advance to the State Tournament. **Dalen Simbler** had 3 of Mead’s 4 hits and scored the lone run for the Panthers on a **Dylan Jordan** RBI single in the 5th inning.

Wrestling – Mead senior wrestler, **Chase Tebbets** is a **Finalist** for the **2019 Spokane Youth Sports Awards**. Chase has been nominated as one of the area’s High School Sports Top Male Athletes.
