What is Destination ImagiNation? DI is about teaching students how to work together on teams, use creativity, and find innovative solutions to complex challenges.

Team Challenges: student use art, technology, performance, or real world experiences to creatively solve one of five challenges

Instant Challenges: teach students to spontaneously problem solve with their teams under a time limit



Who: 3rd through 8th grade students who enjoy...

- Learning to think on their feet
- Using creative problem solving techniques
- Solving challenges
- Working with a team

Teams will be formed based on the students' school and grade level. Elementary division includes grades 3-5. Middle level includes grades 6-8. Students can be on a team that is a grade level above, but cannot compete in a challenge that's a grade level below their age.

When: Informational meeting for *students and parents* on **Tuesday, Oct. 1 @ 6:30pm**, Heritage Cafeteria (for all schools and grades 3-8)

The success of DI lies with **parent volunteers who manage or co-manage teams**. Teams, who are made up of approximately 6 students, meet after school or in the evening, based on the parent manager's schedule. Generally, teams meet once a week from November through March.

Students must be able to attend the all day Regional Competition on **Saturday, March 14 at Bay Port High School**.

Regional winners will compete on Saturday, April 18 at UW-Green Bay.
