

USE OF DISTRICT FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent or designee to loan school District furniture and equipment to citizens and organizations who will use the furniture or equipment for community purposes. Computers, office machines or audio-visual equipment shall not be loaned.

Citizen or organization use shall not conflict with regular school District use.

Any person applying for the use of furniture or equipment on behalf of any community group shall be a member of that group and the group shall have more than 50% of members or participants who live in Brea.

Any citizen or organization using school District furniture or equipment shall be liable for any damages to the property caused by the activity. The Superintendent or designee shall charge the amount necessary to repair or replace the property.

All persons or organizations applying for the use of furniture or equipment shall complete an Application for Use of Furniture or Equipment and a Hold Harmless Agreement (see attached).
