

# **Classroom Management Accountability Plan**

### **Student Expectations**

1. Listen and follow directions
2. Raise your hand
3. Keep your hands and feet to yourself
4. Respect everyone

### **Consequences**

Students are expected to follow the listed expectations to ensure that every student is expressing their own right to learn and enjoy without any interference. If a student is interrupting those rights, consequences will be enforced in the following steps:

1. A warning will be given
2. A time-out will be given in the classroom. The student will be positioned to watch and listen but will not participate in activity.
3. After three time-outs, a letter will be sent home with the student to be signed by the student and a parent/guardian and returned the next day to Mrs. Ronning.

In the rare instance of a student performing any unsafe actions, they will be immediately sent to the office.

# **Mrs. Ronning's Art Tickets**

## **Class Rewards**

Every student is expected to meet the classroom expectation each and every art class period. The class will work as team to earn tickets when meeting the following classroom expectations:

- ★ **1 Ticket earned for meeting expectations of entering the classroom**
- ★ **1 Ticket earned for meeting expectations of volume**
- ★ **1 Ticket earned for listening and following directions**
- ★ **1 Ticket earned for meeting expectations of clean up**
- ★ **1 Ticket earned for meeting expectations of lining up and exiting**

Once the students earn 60 tickets, they will have a variety options to turn them in for class reward. For example: choose your own seat for a day or free choice art day.

## **Student Reward**

When a student is seen going over and beyond expectations, they can earn individual tickets to turn in for a reward. For example: bring a friend and have lunch in the art room with Mrs. Ronning or pick another student to trade seats with.

# ART JOBS

Students will have assigned seats that will be changed at every trimester and mid trimester. Every table has a color, the color designates certain homes for materials and art caddies. Each table will be assigned a job and the jobs will rotate each week. The art jobs are as follows:

**MATERIALS MASTERS-** Responsible for passing out and collecting artwork and passing out and putting away materials in their correct home neatly and nicely.

**NOISE MONITORS-** Responsible for reminding the class of appropriate class volume and responsible for dismissing quiet tables to line up.

**FLOOR INSPECTORS-** Responsible for making sure all materials and scraps are picked up off the floor and sweep if necessary.

**DIRECTIONS EXPERTS-** Responsible for listening extra carefully to instructions and to help answer any classmates questions about the directions.

**TABLE SPONGERS-** Responsible for wiping down tables during clean up.

**SINK MANAGERS-** Responsible for appropriately rinsing and drying materials.
