1. Non-refundable application fees will be charged for first-time students and those returning to Shekinah after a one year absence.
2. Monthly Payment Plan: Tuition is billed the first Wednesday of each month. Payments are due by the end of the month. Any outstanding balance at the end of each month will incur a 1.5% (18% annual) late fee. Accounts must be current at the end of each academic quarter in order for student/s to continue at Shekinah the following quarter.
3. Part time students will be charged for a minimum of 1 full credit hour of classes (\$1,260 or \$1,356). However, if a student takes 2 classes and they do not add up to one (1) full credit hour, the student will still be eligible to play on athletic teams.
4. Students withdrawing between July 1 and the last day of school will be required to pay tuition for the entire quarter in which they withdrawal. For example, if a student withdraws July 10, prior to the first day of class, 25% of the annual tuition amount will be charged. If a student withdraws during the 3rd quarter, their final bill will reflect a total of 75% of the annual tuition amount less any tuition payment(s) already received. All outstanding tuition and fees must be paid in full before student records will be released.
