Daily attendance is a priority at Fletcher. Success in school depends on regular attendance. Any student who is absent from school without a valid excuse three full days, tardy, or absent for more than 30 minutes during the school day on three occasions is considered truant. Notify the office when your child must be absent and schedule appointments after the school day when possible. If a phone call or written note is not received within five days of a child's return to school, the absence will become unexcused. Registration for next year's incoming **Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten** begins April 20-May 22. Make sure you are prepared to enroll your child by having their physical and dental appointments scheduled in March and April. If you need to apply for an intra-district permit (between BCSD schools) for your incoming TK or Kinder student, the window is open only from March 23-April 3, 2020.
