Online Registration System

Hampton One now has an online system for student registration. **If your child is not a Hampton One student and you wish to register your child for school in the Hampton One attendance zone, please use the procedures listed below to register.**

Registration Procedures

Parents / Guardians without internet access can complete the online portion at the district office.

Go to: hampton1.org/registration

Click Start and create a username and password.

Enter the student(s) information.

Create an appointment for final registration clearance.

Bring the following items to your appointment:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card (preferred not required)
- Immunization form (DHEC)
- Proof of Residency (one of the following)
 - Utility bill with physical address
 - Lease/rental agreement
 - Property tax receipt with physical home address
- School Transcript or Report Card
- Guardianship documents if not the parent.
- Parent / Guardian Driver's License or Identification

NOTE: Registration cannot continue without the **birth certificate, proof of residency**, and if applicable the **guardianship documents**.
