



DANCE AGREEMENT

Agreement Conditions: As a condition for my attendance at Homecoming, which is to be held on **Sunday, October 28, 2018 at the House of Blues Garden Walk, Anaheim, CA.** I agree to adhere to all regulations as stipulated below. Should my behavior or that of my guest bring negative attention to Saint Joseph High School, or violate any school policies, I understand that I am subject to disciplinary measures as stated in the Student/Parent Handbook and that I will forfeit my privilege of attending Homecoming and possibly forfeiture of attending other school functions and graduation ceremonies. **Homecoming is from 8:00pm to 12:00am.**

REGULATIONS

1. Anyone dressed inappropriately will be asked to leave. There will be no refund.
2. For Her:
Appropriate dress for the women is semi-formal wear. A semi-formal dress, tea length or shorter is appropriate. Dresses cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the knee. A dress that reveals midriff or excessive skin will not be allowed. Mini Skirts or tennis shoes will not be permitted. Hair with excessive streaks or highlights will not be allowed.

For Him:
Men must be in collared dress shirt and tie with suit, a sports jacket or nice sweater and dress shoes. Tuxedos, zoot-suits mismatched patterns of bright obnoxious colors, tennis shoes, top siders, boots, earrings/piercings, tattoos and informal hats will not be tolerated and will be cause for refusal of admittance to the dance. Outrageous hairstyles and facial hair are also prohibited. Earrings will be confiscated and returned at the end of the dance.
3. Appropriate dress will be retained throughout the evening. Removal of shoes, ties or untucked shirts will not be allowed. **Changing of shoes to slippers or flip flops will not be allowed.**
4. In keeping with the formal occasion, proper behavior is expected. Toys, noisemakers, pranks and throwing objects are not acceptable.
5. Inappropriate dancing or public displays of affection will not be tolerated. Continuous offenses will result in dismissal from the dance with no refund.
6. All purses and jackets will be searched at the time of check in.
7. Should the school suspect a person may be in possession of, or under the influence of alcohol, he/she may be searched and will undergo a breathalyzer test. If deemed necessary by Administration, the student(s) and/or guest(s) will be escorted from the dance and parents/guardians will be contacted by Administration and Security.

Should the school suspect a person to be in possession of, or under the influence of illegal drugs, he/she may be searched. If deemed by Administration, the student(s) and/or guest(s) will be escorted from the dance and law enforcement authorities will be contacted. Smoking is not allowed. All students are subject to disciplinary action as stated in the Student/Parent Handbook, which may include forfeiture of attending other

school functions and possibly of facing other disciplinary action. No refund of tickets will be given.

8. Everyone attending the Homecoming Dance should have their bid and I.D. at the time of admittance.
9. The Homecoming Dance begins at 8:00 pm and will end at 12:00am. Each student must check-in at the door prior to entrance. Should the student arrive after the set arrival time (9:00pm) admittance may be refused and parents/guardians will be contacted. If a student does not arrive at all, parents/guardians will be contacted. Students will not be allowed to leave Homecoming before dismissal time of 11:30 pm nor will they be readmitted.
10. Any questions about dress standards, dance regulations, or the agreement conditions should be referred to Ms. Hercules, Assistant Principal for Activities and Operations (SJHS), or Mr. Avila, Activities Director (SJB).
11. Students who plan to attend Homecoming with a guest other than a Catholic High School student must secure a guest pass consent form.
12. Any electronic devices or personal property brought to dances is the sole responsibility of the student attending the dance. Saint Joseph High School and its staff are not responsible or liable for lost or stolen items.

I have read the above and agree to abide by these regulations. I understand that failure to abide by the above mentioned rules and regulations will result in further disciplinary action in accordance with the Student/Parent Handbook. I also agree to accept full responsibility for the behavior and actions of my guest and will inform him of the rules and regulations, which will be enforced. The SJHS Administration has full authority to admit, refuse, or dismiss any student and/or guest from the dance.
