

Child Nutrition Program

Payment Collection Procedure

The Gorman ISD cafeteria provides nutritious meals for students each day. Students, who do not have an approved application on file for the free/reduced meal program, are required to pay for their meals. Students not having enough money will be allowed to eat one meal with the understanding that the money will be paid in full the following day. Students not having sufficient funds the following day will be given a non-reimbursable meal.

Parents are responsible for keeping up with their children's accounts. Information on lunchroom accounts may be obtained from the cafeteria, elementary office, or on-line with our MealTime Pay Online System. The cafeteria will notify parents of low balances by a written notice. Parents or students can pay for meals in advance on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis; by mail, in the elementary office, in the school cafeteria, or electronically on-line.

If your child received Child Nutrition Program benefits at the end of the 2017-2018 school year, they will receive the same benefits at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year for a "grace period" of time until their new application has been approved in the administration office.

Please note:

The amount on your check for meal payment will be applied to your child's account in the cafeteria. We are not able to cash checks nor give change back from checks or bills. Money taken in that exceeds the cost of the item sold will be deposited in the student's MealTime account. One check may be written for all children in the same household.
