## Pre-College Summer Opportunities in 2020

The following summer opportunities for Juniors, Sophomores, and Freshmen are arranged by deadline date. Start filling out the applications well in advance of the deadline date. Many applications require that you get recommendations, transcript copies, and write essays. Financial aid is provided for many of the programs. Financial aid deadlines are also listed below. More summer program information is posted weekly so check with your counselor often for updates.

### **Due Date   Summer College Program**

- 1-23-20**      **Columbia University Summer College** – Several two, three and six-week intensive programs for academically exceptional high school rising juniors and seniors. Priority deadline January 23 (application fee waived); Regular deadline March 19 (\$80 application fee). Financial Aid is available.

- 1-29-20**      **Stanford University Pre-Collegiate Studies** – Stanford Pre-Collegiate Summer Institutes offers two sessions for high school students, grades 8–11. Each session runs for three weeks and provides a diversity of courses from which to choose  
Session 1 June 22 – July 10  
Session 2 July 13 – July 31  
Programs offer highly motivated, intellectually curious students the opportunity to investigate topics not typically taught in high school. Priority application deadline is January 29. Regular deadline is February 26. Financial aid is available. - 2-01-20**      **Massachusetts Institute of Technology/MITES (Minority Introduction to Engineering and Science) Summer Program**. A six week program for juniors interested in STEM programs. The program generally runs July – mid-August. This is a free program. Students only have to provide transportation. Based on gpa, PSAT scores, essays, teacher and counselor recommendations.

## **Due Date Summer College Program**

- 2-12-20 **Georgetown University**, located in Washington, D.C., will host **Summer 2019 Pre-College Program for Students in Cristo Rey High Schools**. Juniors who are accepted into the program will get a full scholarship covering this three-week program that runs June 28 – July 19. Each CRN school can nominate two juniors to submit online applications. Criteria based on: excellent academic records, extracurricular leadership, aspirations for college, essay, teacher recommendation, and citizenship within your school. Applications are available in the College Counseling Office. Deadline to return application to Mrs. Ward, College Counselor, is February 12.
- 3-02-20 **Cornell University Summer College** – One-week programs for rising high school juniors, and seniors who desire to learn about engineering, math, science, and other careers within an interactive milieu. Sessions are held between July 12 – 18 (Curie Academy – for high school girls who excel in math and science); July 12– 18 (Catalyst Academy – for students interested in engineering) Programs costs vary but some scholarships are available based upon demonstrated need. ## **Due Date   Summer College Program**

**3-27-20      University of Denver Pioneer Prep Leadership Institute – a three-day program for rising high school juniors and seniors. Students will learn about college access and career planning, engage with speakers, activities, and fellow scholars to enhance and further develop their cultural identity. The African American Pioneer Prep Leadership Institute will be held July 22 – July 24. The Latinx Pioneer Prep Leadership Institute will be held July 15 – July 16. Program is free except for program fee (\$60.00 to confirm you attendance to the program). You can apply for a travel stipend to help with transportation costs to Denver.**

**3-30-20      The Young Entrepreneurs Business Week (YEBW) summer program empowers high school students to explore business, operations, finance and marketing through hands-on experiential learning. It also builds both teamwork and leadership skills. Four separate week-long programs will be held on college campuses this summer:**

**July 26 – August 1 at Oregon State University - Cascades**

**July 26 – August 1 at University of Portland**

**July 12 - July 18 at University of Oregon**

**August 9 – 15 at Oregon State University**

**Application online. Open to students in grades 9 – 12. There are six scholarship slots available to De La Salle students. Deadline for applying for the financial aid to cover most of the cost for the program is March 1.**

**3-31-20      Princeton University Young Women’s Leadership Academy – Two-week program for rising juniors and seniors minority girls . **03-02-20      Greenfield Peace Writing Scholarship. The Physicians for Social Responsibility annual scholarship contest. \$1,000, \$750, or \$500 prize for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Open to all seniors and juniors. You must submit an essay, narrative or poem on “How would an effective movement for climate justice benefit immigrant communities?” 600 word maximum.
