The weighted average will be scaled to grades A (90-100), B (80-89), C (70-79), D (60-69), and F (0-59) and further used to differentiate all public schools.

(cc) the methodology by which the State differentiates a school as consistently underperforming for any subgroup of students described in section (c)(4)(C)(iii), including the time period used by the State to determine consistent underperformance;

Student group achievement is monitored annually through the Closing the Gaps domain of the State accountability. Any campus that has one or more achievement gap(s) between individual student groups and the interim goals for three consecutive years will be identified as a consistently underperforming school.
