Kindergarten

- 1 12x18 manila paper (50 ct.)
 - 1 Nylon pencil bag, clear top with grommets (no boxes)
 - 1 Pkg. of #2 yellow Dixon Ticonderoga lead pencils-12 count
 - 4 Crayons - 24 count boxes (Crayola brand)
 - 2 Large boxes of facial tissue
 - 2 Pkg. (4 count each) EXPO dry erase markers (black; fine tip)
 - 2 Elmer's school glue—4 oz. (no "gel" or "no run" type)
 - 2 Crayola markers (classic colors) washable – 8 count
 - 1 Wide-ruled spiral notebook, yellow, 70 sheet count
 - 1 Pocket folder w/brads (red) (paper only, no plastic)
 - 1 Blue pocket folder no brads (paper only, no plastic)
 - 1 Fiskars scissors—blunt end

 - 6 8x10 Spiral composition books, 1/2" ruled, red base-line, dotted mid-line (comparable to EPI #25361 or Carolina PAD #43411—no recycled paper) 36 sheet count
 - 4 Pocket folders with brads (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, & 1 green) (paper only, no plastic)
 - 1 Pointed Scissors (comparable to Fiskars brand)
 - 1 Canvas zipper pouch (no boxes)

Second Grade

 - 3 Pkg. of #2 yellow Dixon Ticonderoga lead pencils-12 count, pre-sharpened

 - 3 Large glue sticks
 - 2 Large boxes of facial tissue
 - 6 Pocket folders, with brads (paper only, no plastic) (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 orange, & 1 purple)

 - 1 Canvas zipper pouch (no plastic pouches or boxes)

Third Grade

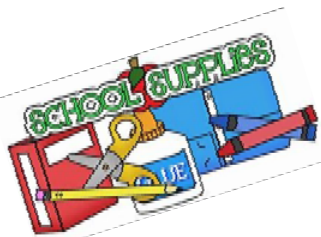
- 3 Pkgs. 12 ct. #2 yellow Dixon Ticonderoga pre-sharpened lead pencils
 - 2 Crayola crayons – 24 count
 - 2 Elmer's school glue – 4 oz.
 - 6 Spirals, wide-ruled, solid color cover (70 sheet)
 - 2 Large boxes of facial tissue
 - 5 Pocket folders solid colored w/brads (paper only, no plastic) (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green, & 1 orange)
 - 1 Scissors, pointed (comparable to Fiskars brand)
 - 1 Nylon or canvas zipper pouch (heavy duty, no plastic)
 - 4 Expo dry erase markers— blue or black, bullet tip
 - 1 Pkg. pencil eraser tops 6 count
