The first round of Keystone testing will take place in January 2019. Proficiency on Keystone exams is a Franklin Towne graduation requirement and as such teachers and students alike have been working extremely hard to prepare for these exams. In order to offer our students the opportunity to take as much time as necessary to work on the exams, FTCHS will be operating on a two-hour delay on Keystone exam days.
