1 The Board authorizes the establishment and operation of an Extended School Day Program in the el-  
2 elementary school to be conducted before and after the regular school day. Emphasis shall be placed upon  
3 extended education services for children even though fees are collected for school-age childcare. No  
4 Tennessee Foundation Program funds nor required TFP matching local funds may be used to support  
5 childcare provisions of the program.<sup>1</sup>

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7 The Board shall annually determine fees to be charged for attending the program, taking into consider-  
8 ation such factors as family income, number of children to participate in the program, and amount of  
9 service provided.

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11 The Board authorizes the use of student teachers<sup>2</sup> and Career Ladder II and III teachers as determined  
12 by the Board's extended contract plan.<sup>3</sup>

### 15 16 Program Objectives

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- 18 1. To provide an enriching and flexible curriculum.
- 19 2. To provide for the safety and health of children.
- 20 3. To effectively use school facilities.

### 21 22 Educational Objectives

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- 24 1. To provide more guidance and increased learning time.
- 25 2. To offer quality homework time.

## 26 27 ELIGIBILITY

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29 The only requirement for eligibility is that the student must be enrolled in the school system.

## 30 31 OPERATION

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33 The extended school day program shall operate on the regularly scheduled school days as follows:

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- 35 Before school—6:00 a.m. - 8:15 a.m.
- 36 After school—3:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
- 37 Any full day session—6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

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1 Children may enroll in one or both of the sessions, depending on family needs. The program shall operate daily during the school year, but may be closed on snow days or other days as determined by the administration. The center will be closed for the following holidays, and others as may be determined by the administration:

2	Thanksgiving Day	Christmas Eve Day	New Year's Eve
3		Christmas Day	New Year's Day

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9 USE OF FACILITIES

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11 Common areas in each school will be used by the program, including the gymnasium, cafeteria, library and hallways. The principal shall be responsible for assigning locations for use and alternate locations when designated areas are needed for regular school programs.

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13 Instructional equipment shall be made available for the program with approval by the principal.

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17 PERSONNEL

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19 The Board shall establish a position of program director who shall be directly responsible to the superintendent. The Board shall determine responsibilities of the program director, one of which shall be to provide leadership in developing and maintaining the extended school day program.

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21 Additional personnel may be employed as the Board deems necessary.
