

2018-2019 Kindergarten – Eighth Grade Angelo Catholic School Uniform Code

The school uniform must be worn at all times except when designated by the principal. The uniform identifies the student as a member of Angelo Catholic School. The uniform is a sign of a student who is contributing to a sense of community, which is important to the Catholic School. French Toast is the approved uniform company for ACS.

KINDERGARTEN – EIGHTH GRADE GIRLS DAILY UNIFORM

French Toast red short/long sleeve regular pique polo top with embroidered ACS logo, French Toast navy blue pleated skirt, navy blue below the knee Bermuda shorts, navy blue Capri pants, navy blue slacks. Belts must be worn. Belts are to be black or brown. It may be a ribbon belt. (No undershirt – that can be seen from the outside – may be worn. ACS offers short/long sleeve polos with the opportunity to purchase the sweater or navy blue fleece jackets; therefore, no other clothing is allowed.)

The French Toast red crew-neck cardigan sweater and the navy blue fleece jacket with ACS logo are the ONLY type of outerwear allowed in the classroom. Only the French Toast red crew-neck cardigan is worn with the Mass uniform. Other pullovers, hooded sweatshirts, or jackets of any type will not be allowed in the classroom. (French Toast navy sweater vest with embroidered ACS logo is approved for Daily Uniform.) Students may wear whatever is needed to get to school, but that outerwear is not part of the uniform and will not be worn in the classroom. Students will also wear their outerwear to Mass, to Music, to PE, etc., but the outerwear will not be worn in Mass or classrooms.

SOCKS - Navy blue or white socks or navy blue or white tights are to be worn. Socks must come above the ankle.

SHOES - Navy blue, brown, white, or black casual shoes or tennis shoes are to be worn. Shoes must be predominately one of the approved colors. Navy blue/white oxford shoes are appropriate. Shoes may not have lights; shoe boots are not allowed.

Basic simple small earrings, a SMALL watch, a small religious medal or small crucifix/cross necklace may be worn. If worn, necklaces are to remain under the shirt. No rings should be worn; fingernail polish and fake nails are not allowed.

Simple, clean, and neat haircuts and styles are required. No etchings in hair styles. Hair must not cover the eyes. No excessive hair coloring is allowed. Hair accessories should be navy, red, white, or any combination of these colors. NO sparkles.

KINDERGARTEN – FOURTH GRADE GIRLS MASS/DRESS UNIFORM

French Toast white short/long sleeve Peter Pan collar blouse, French Toast plaid jumper, French Toast cross over tie. Hair accessories should be red, white, navy or any combination of these colors. NO sparkles. Only the French Toast red crew-neck cardigan is worn with the Mass uniform. Girls may wear white or navy tights or white knee socks with black flats or Mary Janes – NO tennis shoes.

FIFTH – EIGHTH GRADE GIRLS MASS/DRESS UNIFORM

French Toast white short/long sleeve Peter Pan collar blouse, French Toast plaid pleated skirt, French Toast cross over tie. Hair accessories should be red, white, navy or any combination of these colors. No sparkles. Only the French Toast red crew-neck cardigan is worn with the Mass uniform. Girls may wear white or navy tights or white knee socks with black flats or Mary Janes – NO tennis shoes.

KINDERGARTEN – EIGHTH GRADE BOYS DAILY UNIFORM

French Toast red short/long sleeve pique polo top with embroidered ACS logo, French Toast navy blue shorts, navy blue slacks. Belts must be worn. Belts are to be black or brown. (No undershirt – that can be seen from the outside – may be worn. ACS offers short/long sleeve polos with the opportunity to purchase the sweater or sweatshirt; therefore, no other clothing is allowed.)

The French Toast red crew-neck cardigan sweater and the navy blue fleece jacket with ACS logo are the ONLY type of outerwear allowed in the classroom. (NO hooded sweatshirts, even the ACS hooded sweatshirts.) Only the French Toast red V-neck cardigan is worn with the Mass uniform. (The sweatshirts MUST be purchased from the school.) Other pullovers, hooded sweatshirts, or jackets of any type will not be allowed in the classroom. (French Toast navy sweater vest with embroidered ACS logo is approved for Daily or Mass/Dress Uniform.)

SOCKS - Navy blue or white socks are to be worn. Socks must come above the ankle.

SHOES - Navy blue, brown, white, or black casual shoes or tennis shoes are to be worn. Shoes must be predominately one of the approved colors. Navy blue/white oxford shoes are appropriate. Shoes may not have lights; shoe boots are not allowed.

A SMALL watch, a small religious medal or small crucifix/cross necklace may be worn. If worn, necklaces are to remain under the shirt. No rings should be worn.

Simple, clean, and neat haircuts and styles are required. No etching in hair styles. Hair must not cover the eyes. No excessive hair coloring is allowed.

KINDERGARTEN – EIGHTH GRADE BOYS MASS/DRESS UNIFORM

French Toast white short/long sleeve oxford shirt with embroidered ACS logo, French Toast plaid tie, French Toast navy blue slacks. Belts must be worn. Belts are to be black or brown. Only the French Toast red V-neck cardigan is worn with the Mass uniform. Navy, brown, or black crew length socks with black/brown shoes must be worn. No tennis shoes. (French Toast navy sweater vest with embroidered ACS logo is approved for Daily or Mass/Dress Uniform.)

*******The principal has final say about any article of clothing or adornment that may be deemed a distraction or takes away from the simplicity of the uniform. *******

THIS DRESS CODE SUPERCEDES ALL PREVIOUS DRESS CODES.

On Free Dress Days, students are expected to dress appropriately. The school reserves the right to monitor and restrict, if necessary, any clothing styles, hair styles, and /or personal adornments which are judged to detract from the simplicity of the school uniform or impair the learning environment. Parents/guardians will be contacted to bring appropriate clothing to school.

On Free Dress Days, students may wear:

- jeans, plain and unadorned, should not be skin-tight
- tennis shoes
- shorts no shorter than two inches above the knee
- skirts no shorter than two inches above the knee
- skorts, no shorter than two inches above the knee
- sweatshirts
- jogging suits
- nail polish
- jewelry
- dresses
- slacks
- crocs

On Free Dress Days, students may NOT wear:

- flip-flops
- open back shoes
- tank tops
- t-shirts with inappropriate writing
- tennis shoes that convert to rollerskates
- biker shorts
- pajama pants or tops
- make-up
- low-cut blouses/tops
- clothing that is extremely tight
- hats

GOOD RULE: If you think you shouldn't wear it, you shouldn't.
