The goal of the Randolph-Field Independent School District's Child Nutrition Department is to ensure that every student is offered nutritious, high quality meals that support the essential link between nutrition and education; to provide all with excellent customer service by qualified staff adhering to high sanitation and safety standards, utilizing cost-effectiveness and industry best-practices.

#### Free and Reduced-Price Meal Applications

Free and Reduced-meal price applications will available at the school or cafeteria, if you have any questions concerning applications, please contact Cynthia Moczygemba at 210-357-2465. All returning applicants for Free and Reduced-price meals must submit a new application for the 2019-2020 school year. Students become eligible for free or reduced-price meals when the application has been processed. Meal benefits are not retroactive. Please submit only one application per household.

Students who were on the free or reduced-price meal program last year in Randolph Field ISD have a "prior year" status for the first 30 school days of the new school year. If we have not received a new application for these students by October 3, 2019, they will become "Paid" students on October 4, 2019.

#### **EXCLUSION OF MILITARY COMBAT PAY**

A policy memorandum from USDA provides information on implementation of the exclusion of <u>military</u> <u>combat pay</u> from income eligibility determinations for free and reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.

As set forth in the statute, combat pay is defined as an additional payment made under Chapter 5 of Title 37 of the United States Code, which is received by household member who is deployed to a designated combat zone. Combat pay is excluded if it is:

- Received in addition to the service member's basic pay,
- Received as a result of the service member's deployment to or service in an area that has been designated as combat zone, and
- Not received by the service member prior to his/her deployment to or service in the designated combat zone.

A combat zone is any area that the President of the United States designates by Executive Order as an area in which the U.S. Armed Forces are engaging or have engaged in combat. As with other types of income commonly received by military personnel (such as the Basic Allowance for Housing or Basic Allowance for Subsistence payments), combat pay received by the service members in normally reflected in the entitlements column of the military Leave and Earning Statement (LES). Deployment service members are considered members of the household for purposes of determining income eligibility for the Child Nutrition Programs.

**Note**: If your housing is part of the Military Housing Privation Initiative, do not include your housing allowance as income. All other allowances as income must be in your gross income.

#### Reminders

- Free and Reduced Meal Applications are available by calling 357-2465.
- Reminder: All re-applications for Free and Reduced Meals need to resubmit a new application for the 2019-2020 school year. Reapplication must occur each year and be within 30 days of the first day of school. If you do not have a current application on file, meal benefits will expire on the 31st day after the first day of school, which means that students will be charged full price for school meals
- ♣ If you qualify for Free and Reduced Lunch, you also qualify for breakfast!
- ♣ Pre-payments are encouraged; by cash or personal check paid at the school cafeteria.
- Randolph Field provides an online web store to check your student's meal account balance. You may also make online payments using your VISA or MasterCard on our secure web store. There is a \$2.00 convenience fee for each transaction. If a parent has more than one student, they can make multiple payments only being charged \$2.00 once. Once an online payment has been made, an automatic low balance e-mail reminder will be sent. The cafeteria does accept cash or checks. - \$\int\$ Students have a right to decline any food item
- ♣ If the proper meal items are not selected for a meal deal, the student will be charged a la carte prices.
- The monthly menu is available on the Randolph Field website. You can easily view information about what is on our school menu for breakfast and lunch each day. The menu also includes nutrition and allergen information. <a href="www.rfisd.net">www.rfisd.net</a>

#### Menu Information

Lunch consists of an entrée, a selection of fruit, vegetables or salad, bread and a choice of milk. Students may select all five food items or may take 3 food items for a meal deal. Meals are priced as a unit; however, each item is available a la carte.

Breakfast consists of two food choices plus milk and juice. Students may select all four food items or may take 3 food items for a meal deal. Meals are priced as a unit; however, each item is available a la carte.

If a student has purchased a full meal in a day and chooses to have a second meal deal, each item will be priced a la carte. This applies to breakfast and lunch meals.

Cafeteria account balances are carried forward each year. All money remaining in your students account on the last day of school will be your student's beginning balance the next school year. If you have any questions about the balances you may call 210-357-2465.
