Dear Parents/Guardians:

VIRTUS: Empowering God's Children

All persons who interact on a regular basis with our students are required to be fingerprinted and to attend a program – VIRTUS - which emphasizes safe interactions with children.

There is a classroom component to VIRTUS: Teaching Boundaries and Safety Guide. The Diocese of Camden has mandated that this program be taught in our schools. There are 4 lessons for each grade. This school year teachers will utilize the curricula for:

Lesson 1 – Physical Boundaries: Safe and Unsafe Touching Rules

Lesson 2 – Safe Adults, Safe Touches and Special Safe Adults

The Lessons are age appropriate organized K-2 3-5 6-8.

The lessons will be taught in Religion Classes between February 24th and March 6th.
