SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL

The **School Site Council (SSC)** is the school's governance body that makes important decisions affecting the school's instructional program. The council comprises the principal, teacher representatives, a classified staff representative and parent representatives. All interested parents are welcome to attend SSC meetings, which are held eight times a year and are listed below.

The SSC is focused on developing and approving the **Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)**, which identifies and implements curriculum and instructional practices to support high achievement goals. Development of the SPSA is done in consultation with various stakeholders, including the **English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC)**. They are also charged with developing an annual budget for the use of state school improvement funds to support the SPSA.
