



We need your gently used books!!

To ensure we have a good selection of books for our Read Across America Week Book Swap in March, **we will begin collecting gently used books every day until February 26th**. There will be a collection box in each homeroom where students can leave their books.

For every 2 books that a child donates, he or she will receive credit for 1 book. So, bring in 2 books and you get credit for 1 "new to you" book. Bring in 4 books and you get credit for 2 books! The most books you'll be able to take home are 5, but we will accept as many as you'd like to donate. We want to have enough for everyone!

Every child will leave with a book!

The Book Swap will occur on Thursday, February 28th and Friday, March 1st. If credits have been earned, those will be redeemed at that time, or students will simply choose a "new to you" book.

Book Criteria: Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines:

- **Books must be appropriate for grades K – 5 only.**
- **4th and 5th grade – bring books your classmates would like to read, not just picture books. WE NEED CHAPTER BOOKS!**
- **Books must be in gently used condition or better: front and back cover on, no ripped or drawn in pages, no missing pages.**
- **Coloring books, activity books and sticker books will not be accepted.**
- **Books from kid's meals will not be accepted (McDonalds, Chick-fil-a, etc.).**
- **If you are donating a Books From Birth (Imagination Library) book, please be sure to mark out your child's name and address.**
