



The Gwendolyn Tearte Grants 2019 - 2020 Freshman Grant Application



Gwendolyn Washington Tearte graduated from Hallahan High School in 1948. These grants are named and made in her honor by The Tearte Family Foundation. Charlotte Washington, Mrs. Tearte's sister, also graduated from Hallahan in 1952.

Recipients agree to be designated as a Tearte Scholar and to participate in activities when made available. Upon college graduation, Tearte Scholars will consider making a charitable contribution to the Tearte Family Foundation, The Gwendolyn Tearte Grants and Scholarships, so that the fund exists in perpetuity. The Tearte Foundation will fund these grants through 2024.

The Gwendolyn Tearte Grants

These grants are twofold:

1. Three grants of \$500.00 will be awarded annually beginning September 2013 through September 2020 to incoming freshmen students of African American and/or Latino decent. In order to apply, the student must be registered for 9th grade at Hallahan by May 30 of the year they will enter in the Fall. **The grants will be renewed each June after the student has earned a general average of 80% and above and a conduct grade of 85% for all quarters.** The student will become a Tearte Scholar with the first grant.
2. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a Tearte Scholar upon graduation from Hallahan when she completes her high school diploma at Hallahan and enrolls in an accredited college/university in the fall of the year following her graduation from Hallahan.

Application Process for Incoming Freshmen

- Be a registered member of the incoming class by May 1, 2019
- Complete the attached form with an essay.
- Choose one of the following statements and respond in 250 words or less. Essay should be typed, double-spaced, and size 12-font.
 1. *Education: An Important "Stepping Stone For My Life"*
 2. *The Most Influential Person in My Life (non-relative)*
