Rationale

A vital part of any special education preschool program is the inclusion of typically developing peers. The benefit to typical peers as part of this type of class environment is multi-layered. Typical peers in this program benefit from having the opportunity to learn about individual differences, playing a leadership role with their peers, as well as learning Kindergarten Readiness skills within a highly structured classroom setting with highly qualified teaching staff. Students who promote to Kindergarten are among the best prepared students in their classes.

Expectations for Typical Peer Candidates:

Candidates must be potty-trained and pass a pre-academic screening

Demonstrate the ability to follow teacher directions and feel comfortable participating in circle time activities

Must demonstrate ability to interact well with children of all abilities

Date of Birth between 1/2015-8/1/2015

Receives no outside therapy services (ex: speech and language services)

Excellent behavioral, social and language skills
